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## Discovery Corner

Brother Shehu Adam from Nigeria had a very simple, but powerful discovery previously, confirming the number of Rak'as (units) we pray in our daily Salat (Contact) prayers. We repeat this discovery again:

2 1 4 2 4 3 3 4 4 5  
= 19 x 112759655

Note that the numbers of Rak'as in the 5 prayers are: 2,4,4,3,4 respectively and the number 24434 is a multiple of 19. Shehu Adam simply inserted the number of each prayer after its number of Rak'as to make the above discovery by God's grace.

Shehu has another simple, yet powerful discovery. This time, he used the total number of Rak'as for each day. This number is 17, except for Friday which is 15. Thus, he wrote down the number of prayers for each day of the week side by side, considering Friday as the last day of the week. The resultant number is a multiple of 19:

17 17 17 17 17 15  
= 19 x 903774587985

Brother K.Emami from Atlanta made a discovery that relates to the covenant taken from the prophets. In Verse 33:7, there are four prophets mentioned by name, Noah, Abraham, Moses and Jesus. Prophet Muhammad is implied in the verse, thus bringing the total number of prophets to five. The gematrical values of the Arabic letters in the names of these prophets are given below:

Noah = 50, 6, 8  
Abraham = 1, 2, 200, 5, 10, 40  
Moses = 40, 6, 60, 10  
Jesus = 70, 10, 60, 10  
Muhammad = 40, 8, 40, 4

K.E. then put the Verse 33:7, followed by the gematrical values of the above prophets as follows:

33750681220051040406601070106010408404

The above number is 38 (19x2) digits and the number itself is multiple of 19. *Praise be to God.*

### Simple facts to remember about the 19-based mathematical code in Quran:

1. The first verse (Basmalah) has 19 letters .....19x1
2. The occurrences of the words in the first verse:  
Isn occurs in Quran 19 times.....19x1  
Allah (God) occurs 2698 times.....19x142  
Al-Rahman occurs 57 times.....19x3  
Al-Raheem occurs 114 times.....19x6

The statement "*We made the Quran easy to learn. Does any of you wish to learn?*" is repeated four times in Sura 54. It occurs in Verses 17, 22, 32 and 40. The number of (Arabic) letters in this crucial statement is 30.

Sister Parivash noticed that if sura and verse numbers are added together with the total number letters in these verses (30x4), the resultant number is a multiple of 19:

54 + 17 + 22 + 32 + 40 + 30 + 30 + 30 + 30  
= 285 (19 x 15) *Praise be to God*

Brother Feroz found out that Dr. Rashad Khalifa, the Messenger of the Covenant, lived on this earth 19,798 days from November 19, 1935 through January 31, 1990, both days inclusive. The number 19,798 is a multiple of 19 (19 x 1042).

Note also that Nov. 19 is the 323rd (19x17) day from the beginning of a year. Except Jan. 19, Nov. 19 is the only 19th day of a month divisible by 19.

3. The first revelation (95:1-5) had 19 words.....19x1
4. The last revelation (110:1-3) had 19 words... 19x1
5. The word "God" is mentioned 2698 times ...19x142
6. The sum of these 2698 verses is 118123...19x6127
7. The number of chapters is 114.....19x6
8. The total number of verses is 6346.....19x334
9. The word "Quran" is mentioned 57 times.....19x3
10. The word "Quran" is mentioned in 38 suras...19x2

# SUBMITTERS PERSPECTIVE

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## Mission Accomplished

One of the principal duties of the Messenger of the Covenant was to confirm all the previous scriptures, which were delivered by the prophets, and to restore them to their original purity. This is recorded in Quran: "*God took a covenant from the prophets, saying, 'After I have given you the scripture and wisdom, a messenger will come to confirm what you have. You shall believe in him and support him.' He said, 'Do you agree with this, and pledge to uphold this covenant?' They said, 'We agree.' He said, 'You have thus borne witness.' "*" (3:81). Since Muhammad was the last prophet, not the final messenger according to Quran (33:40), this verse prophesies the coming of a messenger after him. Through the mathematical code God imbedded in Quran, His final scripture, God clarified that this messenger was Dr. Rashad Khalifa.

Throughout history, the messengers of God delivered and advocated the same message: **You shall not worship except God (41:14).** They never asked for a wage for themselves (11:29). They all came with profound, divine proof of their messengership (57:25). However, none of them was accepted readily by the communities they were sent to. In fact, the messengers were ridiculed, rejected or even killed by the people who considered them to be a threat to their corrupt lifestyles (2:87). Consequently, the communities who rejected their messengers were annihilated for their wickedness (3:56). In the end, the believers have always been victorious by God's will: "*We have sent messengers before you to their people, with profound signs. Subsequently, we punished those who transgressed. For it is our duty to give victory to the believers*" (30:47).

Each messenger was chosen by God to perform specific duties in accordance with His plan. They will be held responsible for fulfilling the duties given to them (21:28). In his 19 years of messengership, Dr. Rashad Khalifa fulfilled the duties that were assigned to him by God. He advocated the worship of God alone and following Quran alone. He warned the people who idolize other entities besides God that they are following Satan's footsteps. He reminded them that the only way to salvation is true Islam, submission to God alone. He never wavered in his work of delivering the message to such extent that he gave his life for it — literally.

The following is a list of duties that Dr. Rashad Khalifa fulfilled during his time as God's Messenger of the Covenant:

1. Unveil and proclaim Quran's mathematical miracle that is based on the number 19 (74:30-35).
2. Expose and remove the two false verses 9:128-129 from Quran.

3. Explain the purpose of our lives; why we are here, on this earth.

4. Proclaim one religion for all the people (3:19), and point out and purge away all the corruptions afflicting Judaism, Christianity and Islam.

5. Proclaim that Zakat (obligatory charity) is a prerequisite for redemption (7:156), and explain the correct method of observing Zakat.

6. Unveil the end of the world (2280 AD).

7. Proclaim that those who die before the age of forty go to Heaven (46:15).

8. Explain Jesus' death (3:54-55, 4:147).

9. Explain Quran's delivery to, then through, Muhammad.

10. Announce that Muhammad wrote God's revelations (Quran) with his own hand.

11. Explain why most believers in God do not make it to Heaven.

12. Proclaim that God never ordered Abraham to kill his son.

13. Proclaim the secret of perfect happiness.

14. Explain the Quranic criminal justice system.

15. Explain the correct way to perform Salat (Contact) prayers.

16. Explain the correct months of observing Hajj (pilgrimage).

17. Proclaim that the believers do not die; they go to Heaven.

18. Explain women's rights in the society and polygamy.

19. Proclaim the correct *Shahaadah* (declaration of faith): **Laa Elaaha Ella Allah (There is no other god besides God).**

His English translation of Quran, the final scripture, was authorized by God. This translation presents God's revelation to the world in the clearest form. It is a blessing from God for humanity, especially given the fact that the vast majority of people are yet to come to this world.

The Messenger of the Covenant accomplished his mission. As submitters to God alone, it is now our turn to accomplish our goal: **Worship God alone, follow Quran alone.** That is the straight path — the path of those whom God blessed.

## WE HAVE SENT TO THEM WARNERS (37:72)

Four months ago Dr. Rashad Khalifa was taken from this world. He is no longer with us, but the message which God delivered through him is.

You can kill the messenger, but you cannot kill the message.

Whatever you thought of Dr. Khalifa's words, now it is your duty to yourself to examine them, for obviously some were frightened enough of their truth that they committed murder to try and stop them.

You cannot stop God's truth.

What did Dr. Khalifa say that so frightened some Mohamedan governments that they put a price on his head? What did Dr. Khalifa say that so frightened the Arabs that they constantly threatened him?

### WORSHIP GOD ALONE! & FOLLOW QURAN ALONE!

Let us leave aside personalities and examine the basics:

**Fact Number 1:** Today's Muslims are divided into countless factions, each fighting against the others. That, despite the fact that God tells us "Those who divide themselves into sects do not belong with you." (6:159) Wars are fought between "Muslim brothers" in the name of religion. What causes these divisions? Following sources other than the Quran alone! If every Muslim followed only the laws given directly by God they would not be divided...they would be guided. Do you call yourself Sunni? Or Shia?

**Fact Number 2:** God warns us that "The majority of those who believe in God do not do so without committing idol worship." (12:106) We must ex-

amine ourselves to see if we are part of that majority. How can we tell? Read on.

**Fact Number 3:** When the angels fell prostrate before Adam, they were not worshipping him. They were worshipping the One who told them to prostrate. We learn from this that we worship the one whose religious laws we obey (9:31, 42:21). Whose laws do you follow? God's laws alone? Or also the human innovations of Hadith & Sunna?

**Fact Number 4:** Muslims have been taught to perform their religious duties in a way that deviates from the straightforward commands in the Quran. For example, 17:110 tells us clearly "Do not utter your contact prayers (Salat) too loudly, nor secretly; you shall use a moderate tone." Yet Muslims the world over pray the noon and afternoon silently. And God tells us that we should "give the due alms on the day of harvest." (6:141) Yet Muslims are taught to give it only once a year, though it is the right of the needy year round. How do you pray? How do you give the zakat?

**Fact Number 5:** The most important principle of religion, the Shahaadah—commonly known as the First Pillar of Islam—is almost universally nullified by modern Muslims. In verse 3:18 God clearly states the Shahaadah: "God bears witness that there is no god except He, and so do the angels and those who possess knowledge. He is the absolute god. There is no god except He, the Almighty, the Wise." God does not mention any human in His Shahaadah. In fact, verses 37:26-40 show that most Muslims will blame their leaders on the day of resurrection for misleading them. They will be guilty because "When they were told,

'Laa Elaaha Ella Allah' (Shahaadah), they turned arrogant." (37:35) We know also from 39:45 that the reason most put another name with God's, is that they do not really believe in the Hereafter. Do you mention Muhammad in your Shahaadah?

**Fact Number 6:** God clearly tells us that the Quran is fully detailed (6:114, 7:52, 10:37) and contains all that we need for our religious instruction. Do you go to other sources? Hadith? The Imams?

**Fact Number 7:** Those who do not heed God's message are doomed, like those before them were doomed:

*Do they not realize that their territory is continuously shrinking around them, while God rules and His judgment is irrevocable? He is the most efficient Reckoner.*

*Others before them have schemed, but to God belongs the ultimate scheming. He knows what everyone is doing. The disbelievers will find out who the ultimate winners are.*

*Those who disbelieved will say, "You are not a messenger!" Say, "God suffices as a witness between me and you, and those who possess knowledge of the scripture."*

(13:41-43)

If you cannot truthfully say that you are following the religion of Submission as God taught us in the Quran alone and the practices given through Abraham, know that God is the acceptor of repentance. If you choose not to repent and reform, BEWARE.

God has sent His message again through a man. That man is now gone, and retribution is imminent for the rejectors.

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Purifying the practices of Pilgrimage (or Hajj) was one of the duties of the Messenger of the Covenant, as listed in this issue's cover story. Because many of us have not yet had the opportunity to make Hajj, it is important to share the correct practices. To this end we quote the section on Pilgrimage from Appendix 15 "Religious Duties: A Gift From God" of Dr. Rashad Khalifa's translation of the Quran (QURAN: THE FINAL TESTAMENT, Islamic Productions, 1989, pp 661-662):

### Pilgrimage: Hajj & 'Umrah

Once in a lifetime, Hajj and 'Umrah are decreed for those who can afford it. Pilgrimage commemorates Abraham's exemplary submission to God, and must be observed during the four Sacred Months—Zul-Hijjah, Muharram, Safar, & Rabi' I (12th, 1st, 2nd, 3rd months) (2:197, 9:2 & 36). 'Umrah can be observed any time. Like all other duties in Islam, Hajj has been distorted. Most Muslims observe Hajj only during a few days in Zul-Hijjah, and they consider Rajab, Zul-Qi'dah, Zul-Hijjah, and Muharram (7th, 11th, 12th, 1st months) to be the Sacred Months. This is a distortion that is strongly condemned (9:37).

The pilgrimage begins with a bath or shower, followed by a state of sanctity called "Ihraam," where the male pilgrim wears seamless sheets of material, and the woman wears a modest dress (2:196). Throughout Hajj, the pilgrim abstains from sexual intercourse, vanities such as shaving and cutting the hair, arguments, misconduct, and bad language (2:197). Cleanliness, bathing, and regular hygiene practices are encouraged. Upon arrival at the Sacred Mosque in Mecca, the pilgrim walks around the Ka'bah seven times, while glorifying and praising God (2:125, 22:26-29). The common formula is: "Labbayka Allaahumma Labbayk" (My God, I have responded to You). "Labbayka Laa Shareeka Laka Labbayk" (I have responded to You, and I proclaim that there is no other god besides You; I

have responded to You). The next step is to walk the half-mile distance between the knolls of Safa and Marwah seven times, with occasional trotting (2:158). This completes the 'Umrah portion of the pilgrimage.

The pilgrim then goes to 'Arafat to spend a day of worship, meditation, and glorification of God, from dawn to sunset (2:198). After sunset, the pilgrim goes to Muzdalifah where the Night Prayer is observed, and 21 pebbles are picked up for the symbolic stoning of Satan at Mina. From Muzdalifah, the pilgrim goes to Mina to spend two or three days (2:203). On the first morning at Mina, the pilgrim offers an animal sacrifice to feed the poor and to commemorate God's intervention to save Ismail and Abraham from Satan's trick (37:107). The stoning ceremonies symbolize rejection of Satan's polytheism and are done by throwing seven pebbles at each of three stations, while glorifying God (15:34). The pilgrim then returns to Mecca and observes a farewell circumvolution of the Ka'bah seven times.

Unfortunately, most of today's Muslim pilgrims make it a custom to visit the prophet Muhammad's tomb where they commit the most flagrant acts of idolatry and thus nullify their Hajj. The Quran consistently talks about "The Sacred Mosque," while today's Muslims talk about "The Two Sacred Mosques!" In a glaring act of idolatry, the Muslims have set up Muhammad's tomb as another "Sacred Mosque!" This is a blasphemous violation of the Quran, and, ironically, even violates Hadith. The Hadith shown below illustrates this strange irony:

لَعْنَةُ اللَّهِ عَلَى الْيَهُودِ وَالنَّصَارَى اتَّخَذُوا قُبُورَ أَنْبِيَائِهِمْ مَسَاجِدَ

Translation of this false statement: "God has cursed the Jews and Christians for turning the tombs of their prophets into mosques." [Bukhari, Nawawi Edition, Vol. 6, Page 14]

### THE FOUR SACRED MONTHS:

#### Mathematical Confirmation

God states in Quran that "Hajj pilgrimage shall be observed during specific months..." (2:197). These Sacred Months were clarified by the Messenger of the Covenant to be Zul-Hijjah, Muharram, Safar, and Rabi' I. Sister Ihsan Ramadan discovered that the gematrical values of the Arabic letters for these months make a unique combination with Verse 2:197, resulting a number divisible by 19. This is demonstrated as follows:

Month	Gematrical Value of Each Letter
ذو الحجة Zul-Hijja	700 6 1 30 8 3 5
محرم Muharram	40 8 200 40
صفر Safar	90 80 200
ربيع أول Rabi' I	200 2 10 70 1 6 30

Now, write the above gematrical values for each month as one number, and add them up:

7006130835 + 40820040 + 9080200 + 200210701630

Add, also 2 and 197 to the above numbers to represent the Verse 2:197. The resultant number is divisible by 19:

207266732904 = 19 x 10908775416 Praise be to God
